## Chapter 154

## STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

# § 154-1. Unlawful assemblages.

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to congregate on any sidewalk, crossing or street in this Town, in such a manner as to prevent, hinder or obstruct the passage of persons; and it shall be the duty of the Police Chief or his assistants to keep said streets, sidewalks and crossings clear. Any person or persons failing to disburse or move when so ordered to so do by the Police Chief or any of his assistants shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not more than \$500 for each offense; provided that this section may, in the discretion of the Town Council, be suspended on any public occasion.

### § 154-2. Wastewater in streets.

It shall be unlawful for any owner or occupant of any house or lot to throw wastewater, or any other filth or rubbish of any kind, or permit the same to be done by any member of his family, or person in his employment on said premises, or allow such wastewater to flow from his premises into any street, avenue or alley, or upon the premises of any other person, within the Town limits. Anyone violating this section, upon conviction, shall be guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not more than \$250 for each and every day he shall so allow the same to continue.
