§ 10-1. Time of elections.

A municipal election shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November beginning November 8, 2022 and then every fourth year after, and shall be known as the “regular municipal election” for the election of Mayor and Councilmen. All other municipal elections that may be held shall be known as “special municipal elections.”

§ 10-2. Applicability of state law.

Nothing in the laws of the state applying to party registration enrollment or other party procedure shall apply to registration, nominations and elections held in this Town. Except as otherwise provided, registration, nominations and elections held in this Town shall be in accordance with the general laws of the state.

§ 10-3. Voting places.

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 24.2, §§ 24.2-310 and 24.2-310.1 of the Code of Virginia, the Town Hall is designated as the official voting place for all Town elections.
